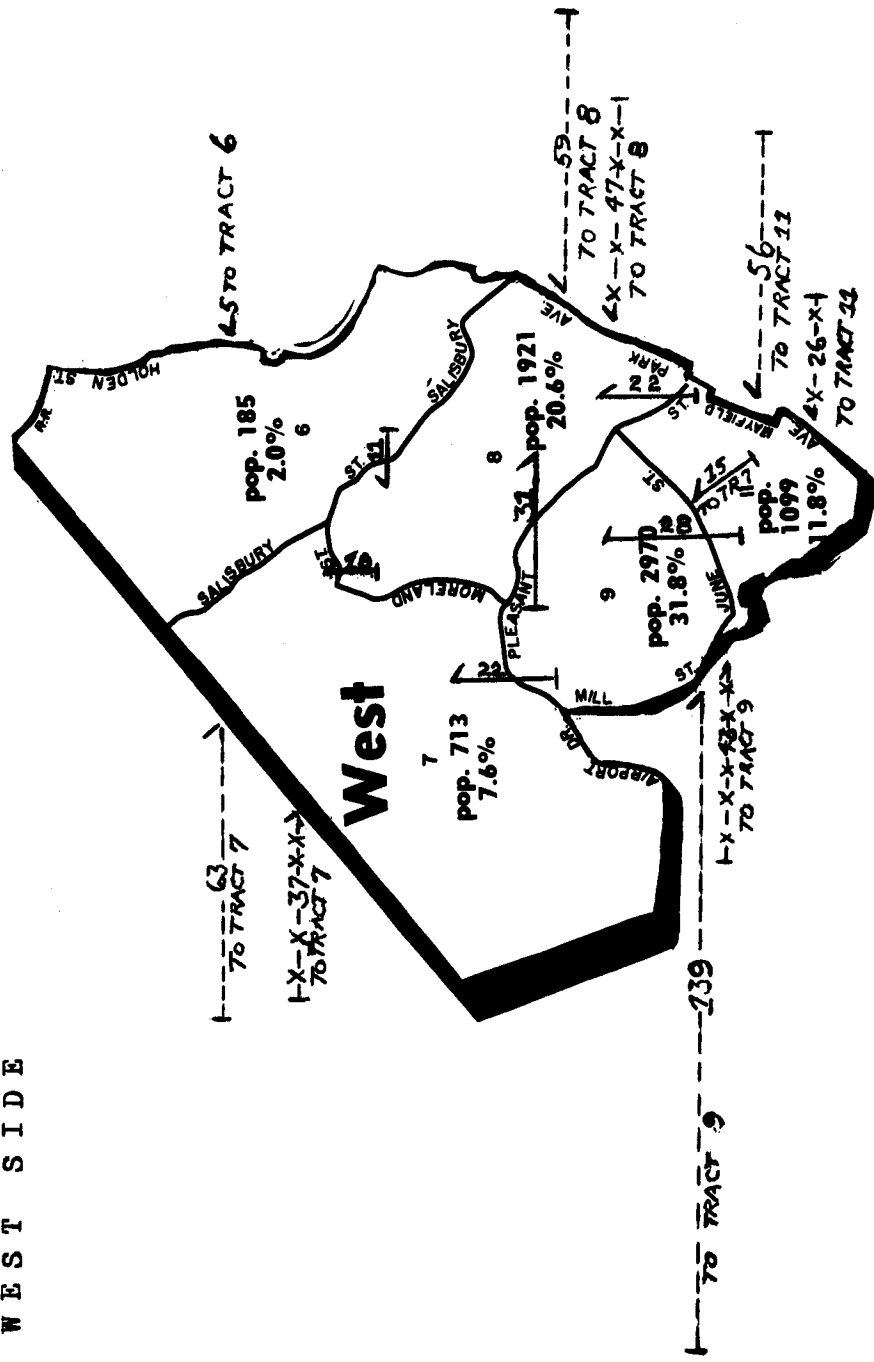


NET MOVEMENT OF JEWISH POPULATION TO AND WITHIN WEST SIDE, 1950-1957

- Question 13. Ask about the Temple and B I separately, because the family may be members of both. Then ask "b", and if YES, ask "c". Check the Synagogue to which they belong. In the cases where different family members belong to different congregations, we are interested in the membership of the Head of the house. If the respondent answers NO to "a" and "b", ask "d".
- Question 14. Street and number of Worcester address, or city and state .
- QUESTION 15. YES or NO, Street, section, or city if out of town.
- Question 16. Names and addresses.
